Mobility

The rear entrance of the building is wheelchair-accessible. All floors can be reached by elevator; the elevator can accommodate one wheelchair and one additional person. Our lower level bathroom is wheel-chair accessible.

GALLERY POLICIES

For the enjoyment of the exhibition by all visitors, we ask that you not talk on cell phones within the galleries, and please turn off all ringers. For the protection of our artifacts and exhibits, NO food, beverages, smoking, or chewing gum is permitted in the Society (medical exceptions apply). Please place very wet umbrellas and coats on coat racks at the entrance. All briefcases, computer cases, and book bags must be placed in lockers.

We allow the use of hand-held digital cameras; NO flash. Recording during the tour is NOT allowed. Strollers are generally allowed unless otherwise indicated. Knives, firearms, and other weapons are prohibited. We have the right to turn away anyone not conforming to these rules. Our building is under 24-hour video surveillance.
